In 1944, a devastating and deadly tornado all but destroyed Greenwood hospital. The day after this catastrophe, Mr. Self announced that he would build a new hospital for the community. On November 1, 1951, Self Memorial Hospital began caring for patients in what was, at the time, a state of the art hospital. In recognition of the incredible generosity of Mr. James C. Self, the Annual Support Committee came up with the idea to establish an annual giving club that would tie into Mr. Self's incredible act of generosity. Hence, the 1951 Club was established to encourage individuals to help Self Regional Healthcare meet the healthcare needs of Greenwood and the Lakelands region by making an annual gift to the Self Regional Healthcare Foundation. The 1951 Club has levels of recognition at \$100, \$250, \$500, and \$1,000 per year. Individuals that join before June 30 will be forever designated as Charter Members in the Self Regional Healthcare Foundation's 1951 Club.

These caring contributors know that investing in the health and well-being of our community is one of the most worthwhile and fulfilling ways to make a difference for themselves, their families, their neighbors, and their community.

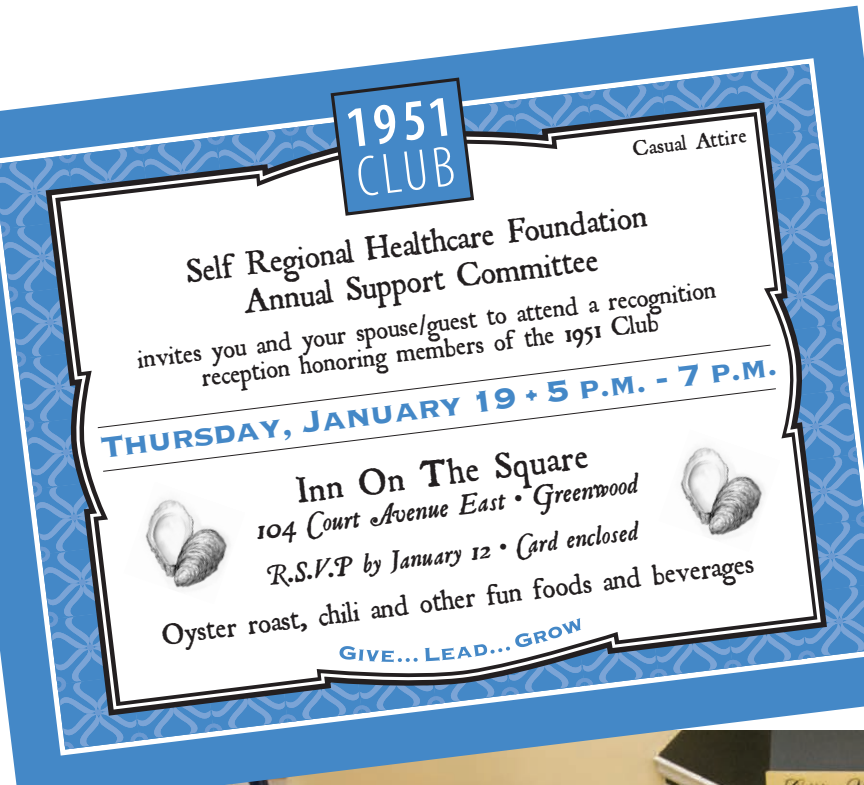

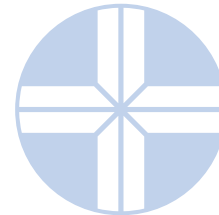

The Gift That Keeps on Giving

"Real generosity toward the future lies in giving all to the present." Albert Camus

The evening news keeps us well aware of the many natural disasters going on around the world, whether it is earthquakes, tornados, or wild fires. Fortunately, there are many organizations designed to help those affected in their time of need. These organizations are largely supported by monetary contributions from the general public. Thankfully, charitable giving is alive and well in the US. According to Charities Aid Foundation, the US has ranked in the top 2 in the World Giving Index every year since 2010.

"Charitable giving" is a broad term that covers such things as volunteering your time, giving blood or writing a check to your favorite charity. One of the most overlooked ways to give back is the act of donating an appreciated asset. Some may ask, "What is an appreciated asset?" It can be as varied as a classic automobile, real estate or stock in a publicly traded company, to name a few.

For brevity's sake, we'll focus on the donation of appreciated stock. Donating stock can be as simple as writing a Letter of Authorization (LOA) to your current broker-dealer/custodian asking to transfer the stock to your chosen charity. The signed and dated LOA should include your contact information, account number and detailed description of how many shares you would like to give. Most custodians require the LOA to be notarized or medallion signature guaranteed. Most commonly, the charity sells the gift immediately and uses the proceeds to further their mission. The charity or cause is especially pleased as these donations tend to be a greater amount than other types of contributions, i.e. check or cash.

You, the benefactor/donor, will receive benefits as well. The most obvious is the pride you get from helping those in your community! In addition, you'll get potential tax benefits for the current market value of the donated asset. Had you chosen to sell the stock, then donate the proceeds, you'd potentially be responsible for capital gains tax (which can be as high as 20%) on the stock's appreciation.

Here's an example: Imagine Mary and Tom purchased 200 shares of XYZ Corporation at \$20 per share (200 X \$20= \$4,000) a few years ago. Today the shares trade for \$47 per share (200 X \$47= \$9,400). If they choose to sell the stock, they would pay long term capital gains on the difference between the sell price and the purchase price (\$9,400-\$4,000=\$5,400 in capital gains). A portion of the gains could be used to pay the capital gains tax; the rest would then go to the charity. However, if they decide to donate the stock, Mary and Tom would pay no capital gains tax while getting a tax deduction for the full amount of the gift (\$9,400).

Even though most of us are working on our 2016 taxes, it's not too soon to start planning ways to reduce your 2017 tax burden. As you consider your options, gifting stock to your favorite charity(s) is a great way to make an immediate impact on your community. If you decide to make a gift of stock, contact your charity of choice or your financial advisor for more information.

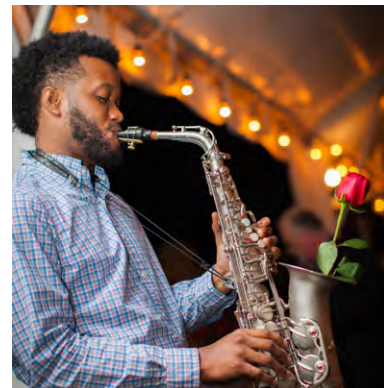

Self Regional Healthcare Auxiliary

We believe in quality service, performance excellence, a professional presence and the hospital's tradition of excellence. The vision of the Volunteer Services Department is to complement the services of the departments and staff that volunteers serve and to be recognized as an essential and credible program within the hospital.

Self Regional Healthcare Auxiliary will be celebrating its forty-sixth birthday in the summer of 2017.

Through the operation of the Auxiliary Gift Shop, Special Vendor Sales and The Lights for Love Project, the Auxiliary has generated income that has enabled it to make substantial equipment donations to the hospital that benefited all our patients and their families. To date, the Auxiliary has given approximately \$2.1million dollars to the organization.

To mention a few of the projects funded by the Auxiliary:

- \$350,000 Verify Safety Equipment for Radiation Oncology
- \$500,000 Towards the purchase of the SRH Cancer Center Infusion
- Wing -\$250,000 in cash contribution and includes credit for matching Volunteer service hours.
- Televisions and electrical wiring for the SRH Emergency Center
- Neonatology bed warming units for SRH Nursery
- Coloring Book and Crayons provided to each child that comes to the SRH Emergency Center
- The Auxiliary also continues to support the Nursery with the New Baby Booklet provided to parents that choose SRH for services.
- Provides children's books to SRH Pediatric Patients.

But more important have been the compassion, understanding and smiles of the volunteers and the many hours of service to patients, visitors and the hospital.

There have been many accomplishments over these years—the equipment, services to patients and the opportunities for education for our young people that are interested in healthcare careers through our Junior Student Volunteer Program.

The Self Regional Healthcare Volunteer Services Department through the Self Regional Healthcare Workforce Development Program provides students with disabilities the opportunity to gain the skills and knowledge to assist the student in making a successful transition into adult life. In collaboration with the Greenwood School District, Volunteer Services promote the transition from school to post school activities, whether that would be employment, adult education, independent living, or community participation. The School- to- work Opportunities Act was signed into law in 1994, and is the plan for all students to acquire the skills and experiences they need for success in life after their schooling is complete. Some of these students have had the opportunity to learn and be productive employees at Self Regional Healthcare.

In August 2016, Sandra C. Williams, Certified Director of Volunteer Services received the Self Regional Healthcare Leader of The Quarter Award, the State of South Carolina Division on Career Development and Transition Award, and was recognized by Greenwood School District 50 with their "Superhero" award.

These hours of service have a total monetary value of over \$800,000.

Scope of Services: Volunteer Services Department is committed to support the hospital and its patients; in an effort to enable staff to better provide professional services.

Services provided through the Volunteer Office change as the needs of Self Regional Healthcare change. Volunteer programs are created upon the request of specific departments within the organization.

Skill Levels of Personnel: Designs programs that are appropriate volunteer activities; which meet the unmet needs of patients and families. Varied skill levels; initial department orientation with annual updates. Regular competency reviews and on the job training.

All Volunteer Services staff members are required to complete an orientation competency and health screening process upon hire. Thereafter, annual competencies are maintained as required by the organization. Specifically; all staff completes mandatory training in general safety, Security, Life Safety/Fire, Emergency Management, Corporate Compliance, Confidentiality, HIPAA and Standard Precautions / Infection Control. Staff members participate in training through other resources related to Volunteer Management as needed and appropriate.

Mary Ella Ruff Nursing Scholarship



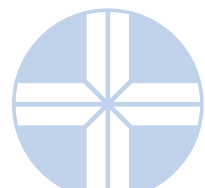

As the primary beneficiary of the tournament, the Self Regional Healthcare Foundation receives funds from the event to support community outreach services for Lakelands area women and their families.

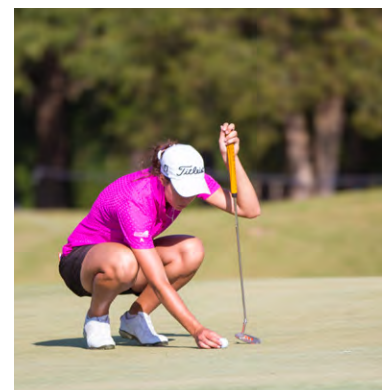
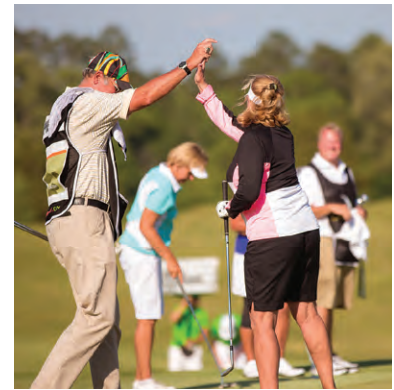

Self Medical Group (SMG)

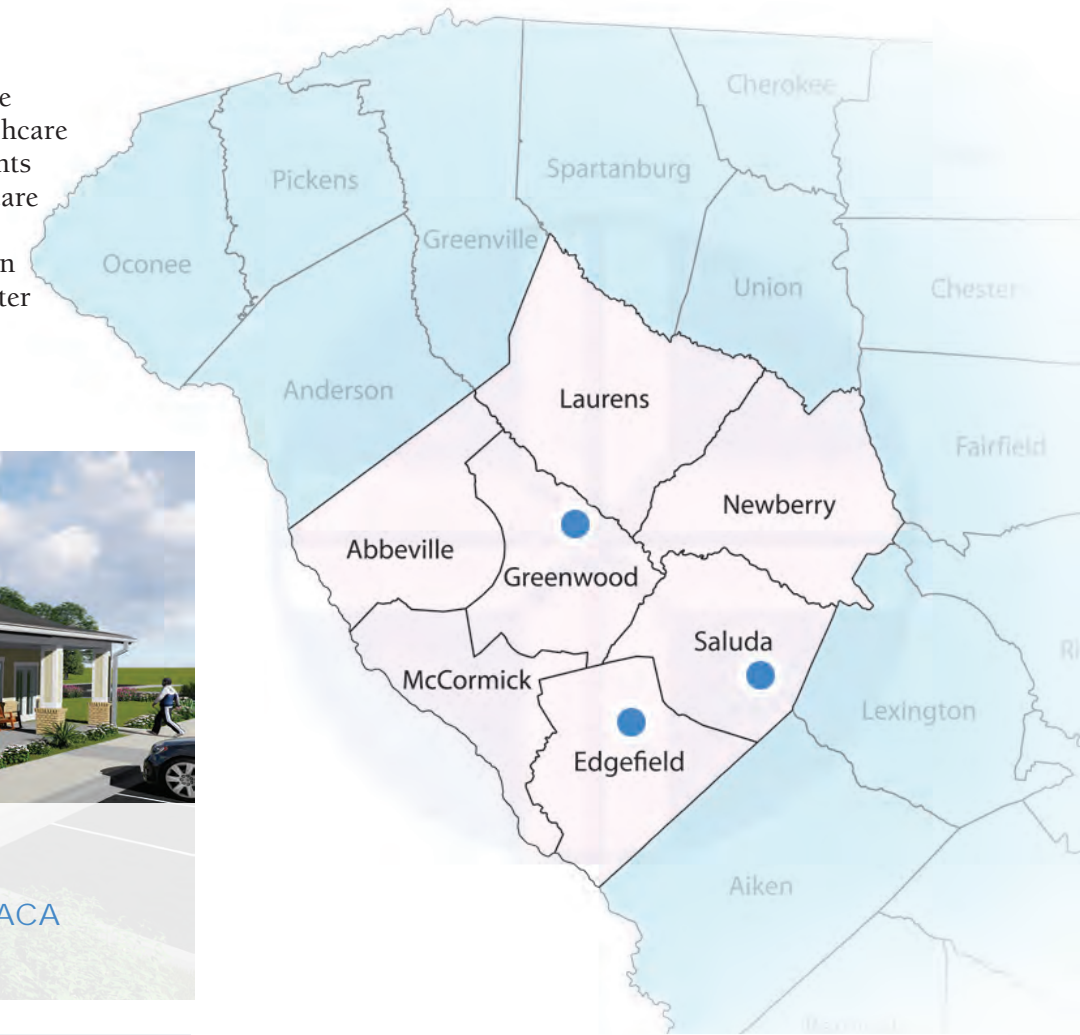

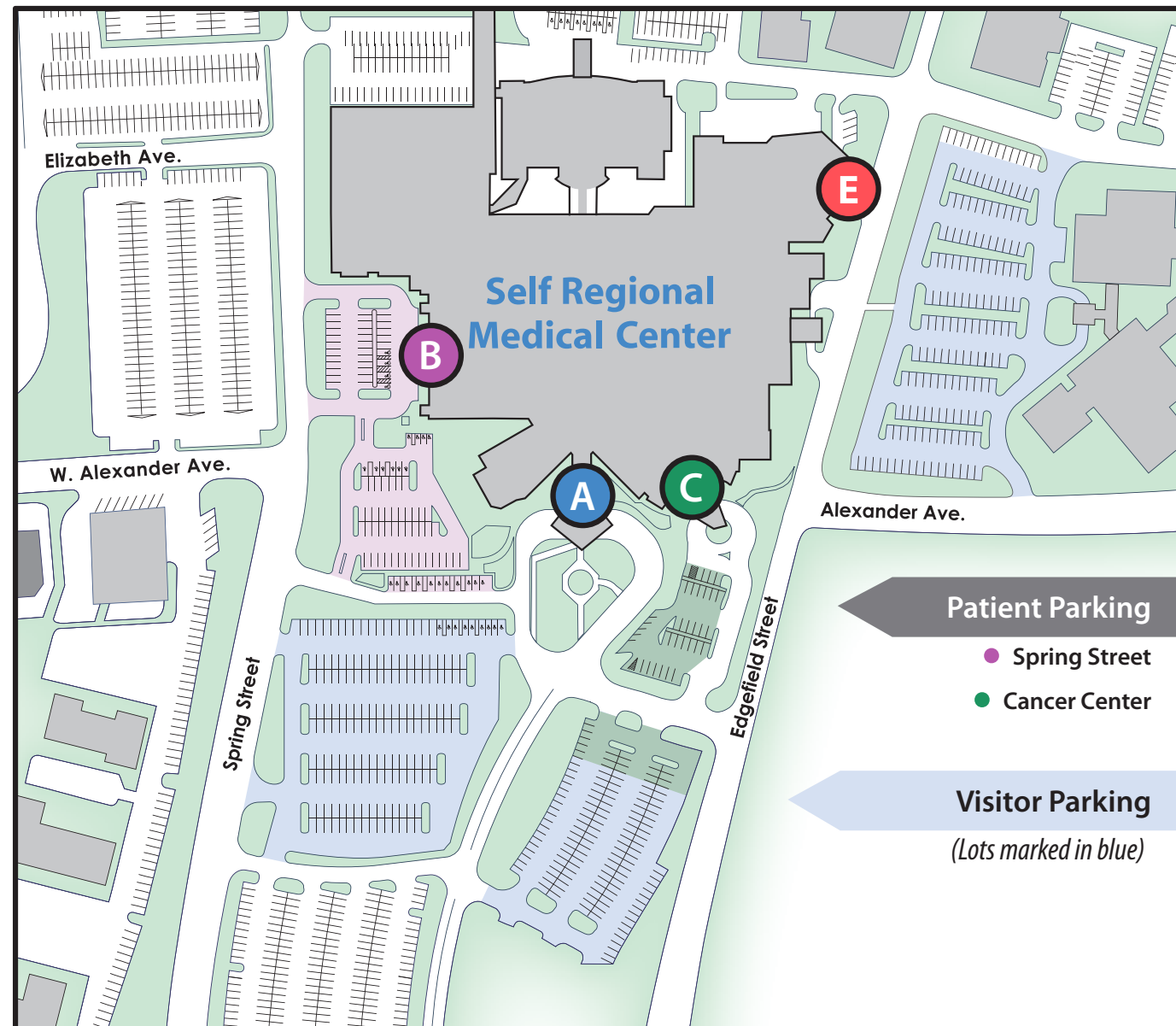

Self Regional Healthcare Foundation

Founded in 1985, the Self Regional Healthcare Foundation was established to generate charitable support from individuals, businesses and local and regional foundations. The Foundation works in concert with the hospital board and administration to help address needs for renovations and/or new construction, the purchase of new and replacement medical technology, and other needs as identified by the Foundation Board and Self Regional Healthcare Board of Trustees.

Please take a few minutes to read through the following questions about why private charitable support is so important for Self Regional Healthcare. We think you will discover some interesting information.



Why does a successful health system like Self Regional Healthcare need to raise money?

Charitable support has always been and will always be important as Self Regional Healthcare moves to more and more outpatient services and as managed care and other cost containment measures are implemented. Charitable contributions will enable Self Regional Healthcare to continue healthcare excellence and meet its responsibility to keep up with advances and changes in the delivery of healthcare to our friends, neighbors, workers and loved ones.

Isn't the Hospital supported by my tax dollars?

No. Self Regional Healthcare has three sources of revenue; from the payment for services provided to patients using Self Regional's services, by incurring long term debt, and from charitable donations. Unlike many charities, Self Regional Healthcare receives no financial support from the city, county, state or federal governments. In fact, Self Regional Healthcare pays a "business license fee" to the City of Greenwood.

How is the Foundation fundraising program organized?

The Foundation's gift income goals and objectives are accomplished through the efforts of five committees; Annual Support, Business & Industry, Planned Gifts, Special Gifts and Signature Gifts. 50 volunteers and community leaders serve on these 5 committees and assist the Foundation by developing community education and service programs and recognition of Foundation supporters that in turn helps to create in greater visibility in the community and increase philanthropic support.

Who serves on Foundations Fundraising Committees?

Volunteer community leaders with diverse backgrounds and expertise, hospital Auxiliary members, employees, and medical staff members who care about the future of healthcare in Greenwood and the Lakelands.

How much money has the Foundation raised?

Since the formation of the Foundation in 1985, nearly \$29 million in charitable support has been contributed from individuals, businesses and foundations.

Why should I give to the Self Regional Healthcare Foundation?

Of all the not-for-profit institutions in our community, Self Regional Healthcare has the distinction of helping the most people in need. Nearly one of every three people in Greenwood County and the Lakelands has some contact with the hospital either through the emergency department, surgery, or outpatient services. As such, Self Regional is one of our most valuable community resources and your support will help Self Regional care for your families, friends, and neighbors.

Doesn't most of the money raised come from foundations and corporations?

Surprisingly, no. National statistics indicate that of all dollars raised, approximately 5 percent comes from foundations, 5 percent from corporations and the remaining 90 percent from individuals.

What is the Hospital family doing to support the Hospital?

Self Regional Healthcare Team Members are in the midst of the Our Vision Is 2020 campaign. Thus far, Team Members have pledged more than \$750,000 over the next five years to support Self Regional Healthcare. This campaign will be expanding to the rest of the Self Regional Healthcare family including the Board of Directors, Auxiliary, and Medical staff.

How will the money be spent?

All charitable gifts contributed to this Foundation, unless specifically restricted by the donor, are deposited in a special development fund account that is used solely for capital expansion, renovation and equipment needs at Self Regional. Contributions raised as part of Our Vision Is 2020 Campaign will be earmarked to support renovations and expansion of our Ambulatory Care, Women's (newborns) and Emergency Care Centers.

Is my donation tax deductible?

Yes! The Foundation is a 501(C)3 not-for-profit corporation so designated by the Internal Revenue Service. As such, most donations made to the hospital are deductible from state and federal income taxes to the full extent provided by law.
