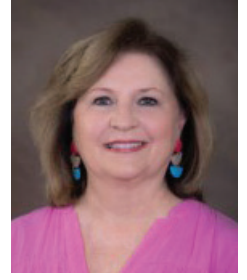

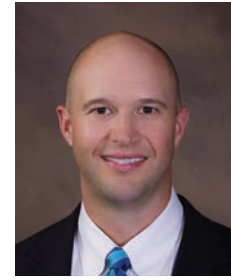

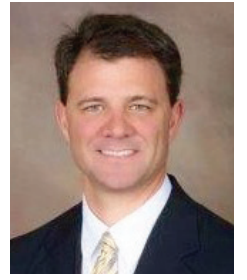

In November 2021, our Foundation Board and Fund Development Committees conducted a strategic planning session to begin planning our next fundraising initiative. We'll formally launch this effort later this year, but we can tell you we plan to seek charitable support for two mission critical needs at Self Regional: The purchase of da Vinci Robotic Surgery technology and the creation of a comprehensive Breast Center of Excellence. These two projects will help Self Regional diagnose and treat the two most common forms of cancer: prostate cancer and breast cancer. These two projects will require an investment of approximately \$8 million. We'll have more on this effort soon, but we hope that we can count on your continued support to bring these two critically needed services to Greenwood and the Lakelands.

# Giving: All In The Family

Dr. John Eichelberger has never worked a day in his life according to his wife of 55 years, Kathryn. “He loves what he does and always has,” she said lovingly looking at her husband. He agreed. “I just knew what I wanted to do early on and that was be a doctor.”

John and Kathryn met in their early twenties and soon married. They lived in Charleston while he attended medical school and she worked as a Librarian. Once John graduated, the Eichelbergers made their way to Greenwood to start their new family life and John’s career working as a Doctor of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Self Regional Healthcare.

Before putting down roots, they had to find a place to live. One that was expansive enough for raising a family. One that had land for horses and farm animals which Kathryn loved, and one that was close to the hospital. They found it all in one place in Ninety Six, SC. That was 1974 and that place is still their home today.

Now retired, John’s career at Greenwood Obstetrics and Gynecology spanned 45 years and by his estimates birthed over 5,000 babies with as many surgeries performed. “I loved surgery. The human body is so amazing and complex. In fact, I performed the first laparoscopy in Greenwood and in Charleston,” he said proudly.

At 81, John doesn’t take retirement sitting down. He is incredibly active and still provides medical care as a physician volunteer with Greater Greenwood United Ministry Free Clinics, and Hospice and Palliative Care of the Piedmont.

Kathryn, 77, is no different in her pursuits. She still tends to the land, the farm animals, and her beloved horses. However, make no mistake, they are together in life and love and being of service to others.

Just ask any one of their four grown children or nine grandchildren. “We taught them early on how important it is to be of service to others and to help one another whether family, friends or someone in need in the community,” said Kathryn.

“Our parents provided a solid foundation for my siblings and me growing up,” said Dr. Adam Eichelberger who returned to Greenwood six years ago with his wife Elizabeth and young children to start his Veterinary practice at Kinard Animal Hospital.

In the Eichelberger’s lives, serving others has also meant giving to the Foundation. “We give because we want the hospital to continue to be one of the best around. We are amazed and fully supportive of the Foundation’s efforts through the Madame Curie Society for acquiring the most advanced medical technology and equipment,” said John.

Adam feels the same way. “Self Regional Healthcare has been a huge part of our lives. It is very important for us to give back to the community and support the hospital, so it stays cutting edge and serves as many people as possible with quality healthcare,” he said. Adam believes whatever he and his wife can do to help build a strong community and contribute to people getting the care they need to be healthy and safe, they are going to do.

For John and Kathryn, their support doesn’t just come from a spirit of giving, it also comes from a place of gratitude. “We have been patients ourselves. We both have had breast cancer, John stated. “We received treatment at Self Regional Healthcare and we both recovered,” Kathryn said smiling back at John.

In tip-top shape now, John and Kathryn love being active, love being with their family and love being with each other. Gratefully, they love volunteering and giving back too along with Adam and Elizabeth. No doubt, giving is all in the family.





# Happy 70th Birthday

On November 1, 2021, team members gathered to celebrate the 70th birthday of Self Regional Healthcare. Named Self Memorial Hospital at the time, they opened their doors to the community on November 1, 1951 with 179 beds. Construction was complete after 3 years and the new hospital began serving patients in the Greenwood community. Today, the hospital has expanded to over 350 beds, and has physician practices across a 7 county region.

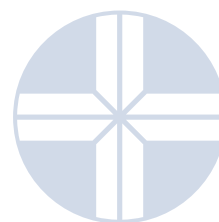

# A New Home, A New Lease on Life

After raising their children and Peter selling a successful business in Maryland, Peter and Irene Bjerke (pronounced BEer-key) decided it was time to find their forever home.

With a list of must-haves in hand and a map of lakes in the Southeast, they made their way to Greenwood. It wasn't long before they realized, Greenwood had everything they wanted in a community and in a way of living. "We wanted to be in a place where we could meet people and get to know our neighbors. We found it all here. Everyone is so friendly and welcoming, plus there is so much to do in Greenwood," said Irene smiling. "Even our friends from overseas couldn't believe what all Greenwood had to offer for a town this size," she added.

For the Bjerkes, one of the most important requirements on their relocation list was easy access to advanced medical care. "We were super impressed by what we read online about Self Regional Healthcare and what we saw when touring the Uptown," said Peter. "It was so comforting to know, if we ever did need medical care, there was a modern and convenient hospital close by," he said. Little did they know in the months ahead and after settling into their new home on Lake Greenwood, they would need the state-of-the-art medical care of Self Regional Healthcare.

"It was a Sunday and we had been to church with our two adult children who were visiting for the first time. We had stopped to get something to eat and I just didn't feel good. As we headed home, I pulled over and the kids volunteered to drive. It was as if everything I was seeing was moving." Once home, the family realized Peter was not getting any better. It was time to get him to the hospital.

Peter arrived at Self Regional Healthcare with all the signs of a stroke. He was immediately taken to the ICU where doctors determined he was a candidate for the clot-busting drug TPA (recombinant tissue plasminogen activator). With Peter and his family heeding the early warning signs of a stroke and getting to the hospital quickly, he received this life-saving treatment during what is known as the "golden hour." This is the time when patients have the greatest chance of survival from a stroke with little or no brain damage.

"Once I received the TPA, I was monitored very closely. The doctors, the nurses and everyone who cared for me and entered my room were amazing and extremely attentive," Peter reflected. "I couldn't have been more grateful for the compassion and concern by every single staff member I came in contact with." Peter, miraculously, walked out of the hospital within 48 hours of arriving. He fully recovered. In no time, he and Irene were back to enjoying all they loved with their family, friends, and neighbors. They felt surrounded by the prayers and support of their children, community, and church family. Peter shared with a glint in his eye, "I am so blessed to have my health back and without any residual effects." Irene agreed it was nothing short of a miracle...his treatment and his recovery.

Although the Bjerkes have always believed in giving back and being supportive of organizations where they live, they wanted to support the Foundation's mission, especially after this experience. The Madame Curie Society provided that perfect segue to giving locally. 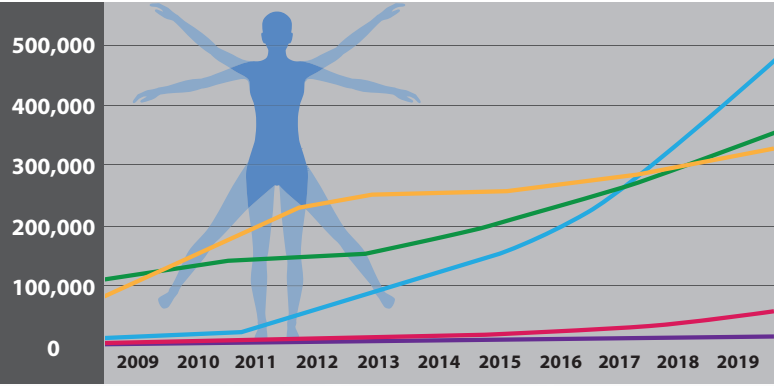


# The Madame Curie Society Banquet 2021

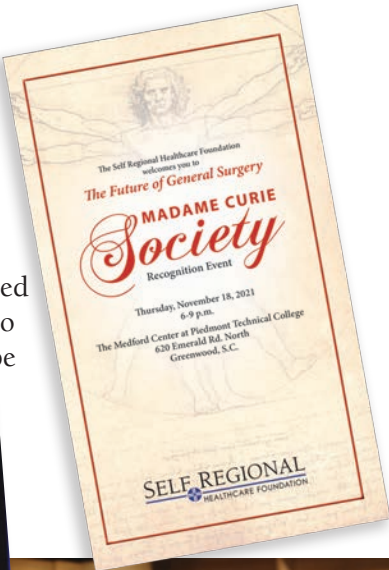

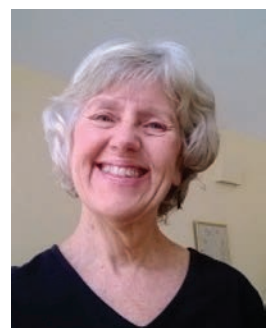

# The Most Common Financial Scams and How to Avoid Them

In 2020, Americans lost over \$50 billion to various scams, be it phone, internet or identity fraud. Some of these have been around a while and some are newer. Here are a few scams or frauds and how to avoid them.

**1. Fake check or overpayment – Common scenario:** You sell something online and the buyer sends you a check. The check could be fake or stolen. Also, they may send a check for more than the purchase price. They then ask you to wire them the amount of the “over-payment.” The check then bounces, meanwhile you have wired “good funds” from your bank account.

**Solution:** Don’t send money back to someone who sent you money. Also, don’t accept a check for more than your selling price.

**2. Here’s a newer, and potentially much more devastating scam: Mortgage closing fraud.** Home buyers are targeted by imposters pretending to be either a real estate agent, mortgage loan officer or settlement agent. They provide their bank account number and instruct you to send a down payment, closing costs or funds from closing directly to the bogus account. This scam could result in tens of thousands of dollars of losses.

**Solution:** Instead of responding directly to an email or text, you should call the appropriate party to discuss the message and ask for next steps.

**3. Another big problem: Ransomware.** Ransomware is a kind of software that holds your computer, tablet or smartphone “hostage” by preventing its use until you pay the hi-jacker a fee or ransom. This has recently become a big problem in corporations.

**Solution:** Avoid clicking on email attachments and links within suspicious emails or un-solicited emails. You should also have anti-virus software installed on your computer and be sure to frequently download any software updates.

**4. Grandchildren and Elder fraud:** A family member calls asking for money to help them get out of trouble, possibly calling from “jail.” Naturally you want to help. However, social media has made it easy for scamsters to learn the names of family members of the elderly and use that information against them.

**Solution:** Hang up and call the person directly to get the details. If they can’t be reached, call their next of kin or someone who may know the whereabouts of the person in question.

**5. Telemarketers and robo calls:** Not a day goes by without a call from an unknown number showing up on my cell phone caller id. Telemarketers use computer-generated predictive dialers to go through various permutations of phone numbers in the hopes someone will answer the call.

**Solution:** Don’t answer! Let the call go to voicemail. If someone really wants to reach you they will leave a message. If you do answer, don’t give out any personal information. Also, to reduce the number of calls, you should register your phone number on the National Do Not Call registry at [donotcall.gov](http://donotcall.gov).

In closing, whether it be snake oil salesmen or Ponzi schemes, throughout history there have always been people intent on defrauding others. Although this list is not all encompassing, it may help you or a loved one avoid a costly mistake. Here’s wishing you a healthy and prosperous 2022!

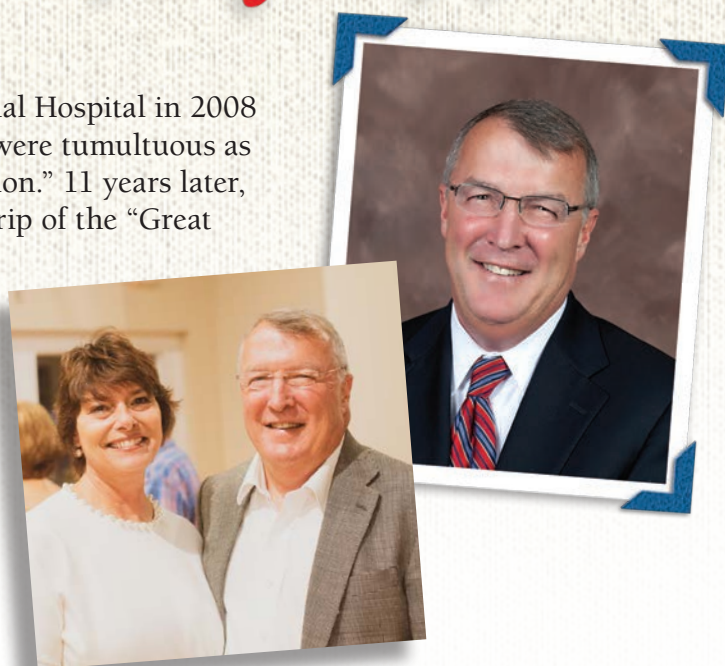
# Farewell to
